

ASAT Conference Travel Grants

The RES Foundation of Dallas, Texas has generously funded a travel grant program to assist in the financial costs associated with attending the American Studies Association of Texas' annual conferences. These grants, ranging from \$100 to \$200, are designed to facilitate the involvement of students, junior faculty, and independent scholars in the presentation of research that aligns with the focus of ASAT.

Deadline:

Submit your application any time after August 1st, but at least two weeks before the scheduled conference date. Please wait to apply until you have received your acceptance email from the conference organizers.

Eligibility:

Open to all undergraduate, graduate students, junior faculty (Instructors, Lecturers, and Assistant Professors), and independent scholars who have had their abstracts accepted for presentation at ASAT's annual conference.

Guidelines

To apply, please provide:

- An abstract of your work. Your name must appear on it. Paste it into the body of the email—no attachments.
- A budget. Grant money may be used to cover hotel, transportation, conference registration costs, individual meals, or other incidentals.
- Academic affiliation.
- If you are a student, include contact information for your faculty sponsor.

Selection Process and Disbursement:

Completed applications, including budget and faculty endorsement, are reviewed internally. Decisions will be made quickly (within about a week). Up to \$2000 in grants will be awarded each year. Applicants will be notified of grant awards via email. Checks will be presented to grant recipients at the close of the conference.
